COMMUTE66 QUICK GLANCE

I-66 now operates as express lanes with a toll during peak hours on weekdays. Solo drivers can now access the lanes, but will pay a toll using an E-ZPass. HOV2+ will ride for free with an E-ZPass Flex. Additional options for I-66 commuters include:

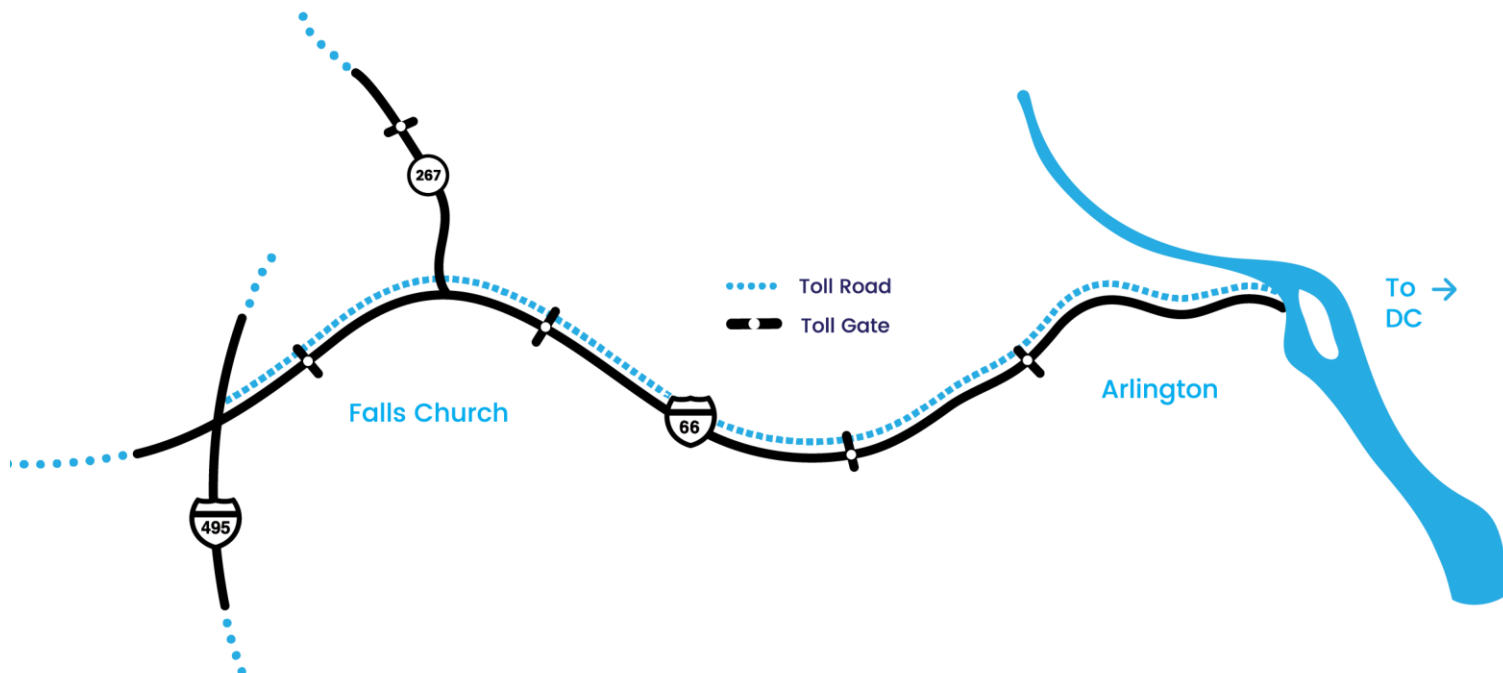
