► Vanpools and High Occupancy Vehicle Lanes

HOV/HOT lanes can be accessed free of charge when commuters ride in a vanpool and use an E-ZPass Flex. Using these lanes can save commuters 30 minutes on average during their commute. Vanpools can access I-66, I-395, and I-95 for free during HOV hours.

► I-66 (HOV2+)

Commuters can travel HOV2+ (two or more people in a vehicle) for free eastbound from **5:30 - 9:30 a.m.** and westbound **3:00 - 7:00 p.m.**, Monday through Friday.

► I-395 and I-95 (HOV3+)

Commuters can travel HOV3+ (three or more people in a vehicle) for free on I-395 and I-95 northbound toward Washington, DC from **2:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.** and southbound away from Washington, DC from **1:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.**, Monday through Friday.

► E-ZPass Flex

E-ZPass Flex is required for commuters traveling in HOV/HOT lanes. The transponder can be set to HOV mode, which allows a vanpool to access the lanes free of charge. Commuters can purchase E-ZPass Flex transponders at Arlington County's Commuter stores, Giant grocery stores, and at AAA locations.
