WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE? RODESA

Rideshare: A common term used to describe various modes including vanpool, carpool, slugging, and services like uberPOOL or Lyft Line; but do you really know the difference? Use the definitions and the chart below to determine which transportation option is best for your commute or for a trip to the grocery store.

Carpool: A group of commuters, colleagues, or friends traveling in a privately-owned vehicle to a similar destination. This mode is typically used for commuting, but commonly used for other non-commute related trips.

On-Demand (uberPOOL/Lyft Line): A service provided by a Transportation Network Company (e.g., Uber, Lyft) that matches drivers and passengers in real-time based on destination, administered through an app before a trip begins.

Slugging: Another unique rideshare option where commuters are picked up at Park & Ride lots by drivers in a privately-owned vehicle, typically outside the Beltway. Neither rider nor driver know each other, but are able to access HOV/HOT lanes for free by meeting HOV requirements and using an E-ZPass Flex.

Vanpool: A group of commuters (recommended: at least 5 passengers) traveling in a rented or leased van to a similar destination. This mode is solely used for commuting. Workers can use commuter benefits to help pay for a vanpool.
